REPORT OF ACADEMIC VISIT TO NAYAGARH

The UG and PG students along with faculty members of the department of Chemistry, Salipur College (Autonomous) had visited the department of Chemistry, Nayagarh Autonomous College, Nayagarh on 05.02.2025. A total of 90 students from UG 2nd and 3rd year and PG 1st and 2nd year along with the faculty members Dr. Asit Parija, Reader and Head, Mrs. Rina Swain, Reader, Ms. Chandini Sahoo, Lecturer and Ms. Shriya Sakul Bal, Lecturer and Mrs. Gayatri Mohanty, Demonstrator had visited Nayagarh Autonomous College. The College is at a distance of 136 km from Salipur College (Autonomous) situated in Nayagarh district.
