### STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2015-16

Institution has designed the OFFLINE questionnaires to assess the institutional performance through Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and for which feedback forms provided to the students. At about 540 students took part in the SSS. A group of teachers under the leadership of Academic bursar analyzed the feed backs and are submitted as follows.

#### The result of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is summarized as below:

The Student Satisfaction **Survey** focuses on the overall learning experience of the students. The SSS was conducted as per the standard questionnaire provided by the NAAC Bangalore. The brief observations about the survey are as follows:

- Total 540 responses are obtained from the students of UG level programmes.
- 56.8% male and 43.2% female students participated in this Survey.
- The students from Final year.B.A./B.Com./ B.Sc., Second Year. B.A. /B.Com./ B.Sc. involved in the survey.
- Average Student Satisfaction Index: 95.81 %
