This Memorandum is based on approval of five science departments of Salipur Autonomous College i. e., Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany and Zoology by Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India under STAR COLLEGE SCHEME .

This Memorandum will be between the concerned departments of Ravenshaw University, Cuttack and Salipur Autonomous College, Salipur, Cuttack. Odisha.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 03, March 2021 (Effective Date) to establish an affiliation by and between

Ravenshaw University, having expertise in the areas of Scientific education and research at Cuttack, Odisha, India hereinafter referred to as RU, of the FIRST PART,

And

Salipur Autonomous College, a center of higher learning at, Salipur, Cuttack. Odisha. India herein after referred to as SAC, of the Second Part, for the purpose of exchange of faculty and students.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as *institute* and collectively as *institutes*.

## Preamble

WHEREAS, RU and SAC have many areas of common interest in Science considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research.

NOW THEREFORE, RU and SAC have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

## ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

### a. Faculty/Scientist/Staff Exchanges

- (i) The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions,
- (ii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest,
- (iii) Conducting lectures,
- (iv) Undertaking joint research,
- (v) Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions,
- (vi) Co-supervising graduate students in Project work.
- (vii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work as per DBT-Star College Scheme guidelines.

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A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning honorarium, travel funding, and housing will be worked out between the institutes.

b. Student Exchange

- a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- d) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-à-vis those offered at the home institution.
- e) Accommodation and living expenses for student exchange programme will be borne by the students.
- f) Expenses on consumables for student project work will be paid as per DBT-Star College Scheme guidelines.

c. Others.

- (i) to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- (ii) to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.

RU and SAC agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions.

**ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of RU, and a programme coordinator from the side of SAC, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

**ARTICLE 3: VALIDITY**

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

**ARTICLE 4: TERMINATION**

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither RU nor SAC will be

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responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, RU and SAC will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

#### **ARTICLE 5: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS**

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

#### **ARTICLE 6: ADHERENCE TO LAWS**

Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the host countries and rules and regulations of the institutions.

#### **ARTICLE 7: DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, VC, RU and Principal, SAC will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility

RU and SAC welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology Deemed to be University, Bhubaneswar**

AND

**Salipur Autonomous College, Odisha**

The Memorandum of Understanding ( hereinafter referred to as MoU ) is being entered into on this 19<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021 at Bhubaneswar,

By and Between

Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) Deemed to be University having its registered office at Patia, Bhubaneswar-751024, Odisha (hereinafter referred to as KIIT ) of the First party;

AND

The Salipur Autonomous College located at Salipur, Cuttack is hereby referred as Second Party

### 1. OBJECTIVES

The MoU relates to proposed links between the University and the Institutions. The parties propose to Co-operate in discussions and joint activities in relation to the following :

Establishment of a research partnership which provides opportunities for the University and College to carry out and publish joint research, joint projects and joint patent.

#### Responsibilities of 1<sup>st</sup> Party :

- Undertake joint research, including publications and other appropriate activities, between staff and/or students from each institutions;
- Facilitates the exchange of staff, students and researchers for the purpose of teaching, study and academic research;
- Provides the laboratory, academic and research facility
- Provides administrative support for growth of academic research in association with the College.
- Provides mentor advice and support to the collaborative institution for growth of its academic and research.

## **Responsibilities of 2<sup>nd</sup> Party :**

- Identification of areas of possible mutual academic interest,
- Identification of potential research opportunities and initiatives
- The dissemination of information and the sharing of experiences among staff and students

## **2. PERIOD**

This MoU is effective from the date of signature by both parties for a period of two calendar years. It can be extended on mutual agreement of both the parties.

## **3. DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

If either party has any issues, concerns or complaints about any matter arising out of or in connection with this MoU, that party shall notify the other party and the parties shall then seek to resolve the issue by a process of consultation. If the issue cannot be resolved within a reasonable period of time, the matter shall be escalated to the University Secretary on behalf of the University and (Registrar of the KIIT Deemed to be University) on behalf of the Salipur Government College.

## **4. CHARGES AND LIABILITY**

The parties shall each bear their own costs and expenses incurred in complying with their obligations under this MoU.

Both parties shall remain liable for any losses or liabilities incurred due to their own or their employees or agents actions and neither party intends that the other party shall be liable for any loss it suffers as a result of this MoU.

## **5. STATUS**

This MoU is not intended to be legally binding (except in relation to paragraph 4), and not legal obligations or legal rights shall arise between the parties from this MoU. The Parties enter into this MoU intending to honour all their obligations.

Nothing in this MoU is intended to, or shall be deemed to, establish partnership or joint venture between the parties, constitute either party as the agent of the other party, nor authorize either of the parties to make or enter into any commitments for or on behalf of the other party.



This MoU is subject to the conditions and recommendations of the academic approval process of the University being satisfied and to the granting of all applicable licenses as required by the University, the Institution or any relevant government or public authorities.

If this MoU is translated into any other language, the English language version of this MoU shall prevail.
